ST. NICHOLAS ACADEMY CHANGING 'LOCATION'

At the end of June, 2010 our parish school of S.N.A. will relocate to the current location of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart School in Reading. OLSH School will close its doors, just as St. John & Holy Trinity schools did 3 years ago, and reopen as St. Nicholas Academy, which will still abide by the code of regulations etc. set forth at its establishment 3 years ago. The only 'change' will be the location and an increase in student enrollment. St. John Parish will still be obligated to the financial support that was originally agreed upon.
