This Tuesday, June 1st, marks the last day of the 2009-2010 school year for students & teachers of St. Nicholas Academy.

Sadly, it also marks the last day of classes in our parish school building. St. John Parish has been blessed with the ability to have

provided 105 years of elementary education within those walls and we are grateful to everyone who worked to make that possible through St. John School and St. Nicholas Academy.

Listed here are a few facts regarding the future of S.N.A. and our parish school building:

FACT 1: This does not mean that St. John Parish no longer has a Parish School; it just means that our Parish School, St. Nicholas Academy, will no longer be located in Deer Park. This summer, after the official and final closing of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart School, St. Nicholas Academy will 'relocate' to the campus of Our Lady of Sacred Heart Parish in Reading and accept the parish of OLSH as a third covenanted parish to support the regional school of St. Nicholas Academy.

FACT 2: Although now located in Reading, St. Nicholas Academy will still be St. Nicholas Academy, with the same mascot, school colors, students, teachers, & principal, and all three of the covenanted parishes will still support the school both financially and prayerfully, providing a long and prosperous existence for future generations of parish youth!

FACT 3: Members of our parish Pastoral Council and Finance Commission, with the blessing of the Archdiocese, are working with a realtor to obtain a tenant or tenants for the school building. If you know of a group, business, or school looking to lease building space, either temporarily or permanently, please call a Council member or the Parish Office.
