F.Y.I. – FROM THE 'WILDCAT WIRE'On Wednesday,

June 23, 2010 the members of the Deer Park Board of Education passed a resolution to notify the Ohio Dept. of Education and the Ohio Dept. of Taxation that they are pursuing the potential placement of a bond issue on the ballot in November of 2010. The bond issue is not to exceed 30 million dollars, and the funding would go toward the renovation of the current Deer Park Jr. Sr. High school and toward building a NEW Pre-K-5 elementary school. A BOND is used for buildings (bricks & mortar), facility renovations, technology, etc.
