**PASTORAL COUNCIL UPDATE!**

1) Your Pastoral Council, Finance Commission & Real Estate Committee have approved moving forward with negotiations for the 'Mary, Seat of Wisdom High School Studies Group' to lease space in the parish school building for one day each week of the upcoming school year!

2) At their joint meeting on June 28<sup>th</sup> the Consensus of Council was to approve the Parish Budget presented by the parish Finance Commission.

3) Discussion took place regarding improvements to the parish buildings especially the church. Facilities Manager, Jim Siegel, is currently gathering bids for replacing the church boiler and water heater; both are the originals from 1967. Music Director, Bob Jablonski, is gathering bids for a new sound system for the church.
